

## Environmental Sensitivity Index – Phase III Storyboard

13-16 March 2016



Purpose: To deliver final products associated with the Laamu Atoll Environmental Sensitivity Index (ESI) project, including a map atlas, geodatabase, technical instruction, and supporting documentation.

### Highlights

- Final project deliverables, including a map atlas and geodatabase, were formally turned over to the Maldives Government.
- A Senior Leader Workshop and Technical Workshop were held in Malé to explain the ESI results.
- A trip to Laamu Atoll allowed the team to deliver ESI projects to MNDF Central Command and the Laamu Atoll Council.
- Satellite imagery acknowledgement letters were collected from MNDF, EPA and the Maldives Land Survey Authority.
- Feedback was received from key stakeholders to enhance future ESI work.
